Full refunds will be given for notification of a scratch requiring a veterinarian's letter (injury or bitch in season) if the HT Secretary is notified prior to the start of the test. NO refunds for no-shows.

**Running Order**

Master Limited to 66

Dogs will run in catalog order. It is the handler's responsibility to be ready to go to the first blind when called. Handlers with entries in more than one stake must report a conflict to the marshal before the start of the tests. Camouflage or dark clothing is required for the test participants. Observers in the gallery should be in dark clothing and keep their talking to a quiet level to avoid distracting the working dogs. Bitches in season are not allowed on the grounds. There will be no training allowed on the test grounds beginning 24 hours before the tests begin and until after all tests are completed.
